STUDENT STRENGTH PARTICULARS

In Toto 693 UG students were enrolled in this academic year. Off these 558 are men and 135 are women. Among the total strength of the college 355 belongs to Scheduled castes, 35 Scheduled tribes and 264 from other backward communities.

About 106 students have joined in PG courses. Off these 34 students in M.Sc., Zoology, 15 in M.Sc., Botany, 20 in M.Sc., Maths, 10 in M.Sc., Chemistry, 34 in M.Com., 2 in M.A., Economics, 8 in M.A. English.

SCHOLARSHIP

The Government of Andhra Pradesh was kind enough to sanction an amount of Rs. 13,16,898 for renewal of Second and Final year Degree students and an amount of Rs 14,2,758 for newly joined First year students. Further an amount of Rs. 15,16,770 to the PG students for this academic year. UGC - COMMUNITY COLLEGE

This college was added with a coloured feather of UGC - Community College in its cap during this academic year 2016-17 with a grant of 57.46 Lakhs. It has well equipped Tailoring lab with 15 domestic sewing machines, Cutting table and ironing table, computerized office room. About 10 teaching staff and 6 non-teaching staff are enriching it.
