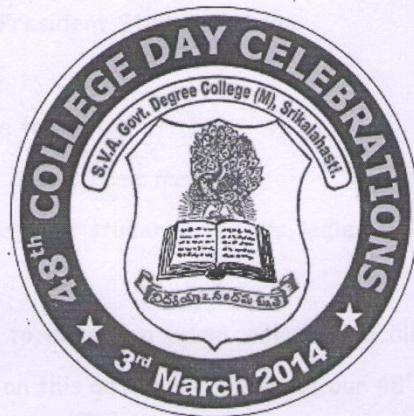

There are 819 students on rolls this year. Of these 700 are boys and 119 are girl students. Among the total students, 422 belong to Schedule Caste, 37 belong to Schedule Tribes and 292 are from Backward Communities.

The Government of Andhra Pradesh has sanctioned an amount of Rs.9,71,910 towards the renewal for the II and III Year Degree Students. The College extend its full support to the students in the process of Online submission of Scholarships and redressing their grievances if any.

Student Support Services:

2. Literary cum reading room has about 38,736 books with a subscription for 12 journals and 11 daily newspapers to update students' knowledge.
3. Four fully air conditioned computer laboratories for Commerce, Computer Applications, Computer Science and Career Oriented Programs are available to enhance the aptitude of the students.
4. MANA TV programs from CCE, Hyderabad are telecasted and can be viewed in MANA TV room.
5. Jawahar Knowledge Centre (JKC), a flagship program of CCE, Hyderabad is extending its support to the student community in 'earn while you learn' system.
6. A well equipped gymnasium extends its support to excel in sports and games.
7. Two NSS Units with 300 volunteers gives ample scope to render social service.
8. One NCC Unit with 50 cadets helps to encourage patriotic fervor among students.
9. The College has S.C. & S.T. Remedial Coaching Centre to cater the needs of marginalized students.
10. To mitigate the student problems the college has Grievance & Redressal Cell.

11. Equal Opportunity Cell caters services to SC, ST, OBC & Minorities.
12. Career Guidance Cell helps the students to choose the right course and opportunities during and after their Graduation.
13. The Youth Red Cross Wing of this college actively participates in blood donation camps.
14. The Red Ribbon Club creates AIDS awareness in the student community.
15. Women Empowerment Cell empowers and educates girl students'.
16. Our College coaches for various competitive examinations through its Entry in Service.
17. Dr.B.R.Ambedkar Open University Study Centre that caters to the needs of more than 600 students to pursue various degree courses privately.
18. Our College has got a new feather in its cap. It has been sanctioned with a new Study Centre of Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU).

To accomplish qualitative and quantitative results in the University Examinations and co-curricular & extra-curricular activities we further require 10 more class rooms and one spacious seminar hall, a Ladies waiting room and a compound wall to avert encroachments and for the safety of our institution.

NCC Activities:

To imbibe patriotism, our college encourages students to join NCC. Under the able leadership of Lieutenant Dr.R.Venu Gopal, Reader in Physics, the cadets attended two National Integration Camps. Our cadets participated in various NCC Camps, AIDS Awareness rally and Voter's Day rally. This year 17 cadets appeared for 'C' Certificate Examination.

NSS Activities:

The college has two NSS units with 300 volunteers. Under the able supervision of Program Officers, Sri O.P.Prasad and Dr.N.Murali the two units organised clean and green programs, voter's awareness rally and AIDS Awareness rally etc. The units observed World Environment Day and conducted an awareness program on Drug Abuse and Trafficking.

A total of 95 students in three batches are undergoing training under the JKC program. In addition to that a special batch consisting of 48 students are also attending the Tally Classes. C. District Resource Centre (DRC):

The District Resource Centre of Our College has won the best DRC in the district for 2013 and the credit goes to Dr.N.Murali who initiates student centered programs. K.Penchalaiah, B.Suresh and K.Narasimha Rao have won prizes at District Level essay writing and quiz competitions. A total of 107 students benefitted from three coaching programs organized by the DRC GDC Srikalahasti.

Sports & Games:

With guidance and support of our beloved MLA Sri B.Gopalkrishna Reddy garu, a new stadium with Rs. 2.10 crores is coming up in our college premises and we hope this further boost our students in bringing laurels to the college in sports and games.

Our college teams participated in S.V.University Inter-Collegiate tournament in Kabaddi, Volley ball, chess, cricket and athletics. With expertise & supervision of our Physical Director Dr.P.Satyanarayana Reddy, the college team stood first in kabaddi.

Two of our players, Samrat of III B.Com. and Surendra of II B.A. selected to represent S.V.University kabaddi team.

Our staff Sri O.P.Prasad, in-charge of Botany Department has won the II prize in chess competition at Inter-Collegiate Staff Tournament at S.V.University. Our Physical Director Dr.P.Satyanarayana Reddy was the coach of the S.V.University Athletic Team that took part in All India Athletic Meet at Patiala, Punjab.

Red Ribbon Club:

Dr.P.Satyanarayana Reddy trained as Master Trainer of Red Ribbon Club and organized AIDS sensitization program in the colleges of Satyavedu, Srikalahasti, Yerpedu and Renigunta.

National Assessment and Accreditation Council has accredited our college with 'B' Grade and we are working earnestly and sincerely to get 'A' Grade for our college in the next accreditation.

Rashtriya Uchcharat Shiksha Abhiyan (R.U.S.A.):
