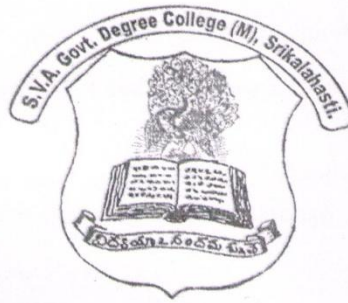

- Free vehicle and plastic day is being observed in every month of 3<sup>rd</sup> week of Friday.
- Every day regular classes start with Morning Assembly.
