Report on Industrial Visit to Glory Pharma Chem Pvt. Ltd.

Executive summary

The visit aimed to provide students with practical exposure to the industrial processes and to bridge the gap between academic learning and real-world application.

Orientation session conducted by Dept. of Chemistry

An orientation session was organized by the Department of Chemistry on 05.8.2024 at SVA Govt. Degree College (M), Srikalahasti, in anticipation of the upcoming industrial visit to Glory Pharma Chem Pvt. Ltd. The primary objective of this session was to prepare students by aligning the visit's focus with the relevant topics covered in their syllabus.

Dr. Reddy provided a comprehensive overview of the company, its history, and its mission to produce high-quality pharmaceutical products. He emphasized the company's commitment to quality, and safety, and shared his vision for the future of the pharmaceutical industry. Dr. Reddy also highlighted the importance of industry-academia collaboration in fostering the next generation of chemists and industry professionals.





Tour of the Facilities:

1. Warehouse: The first stop on our tour was the warehouse, where raw materials and finished products are stored. The warehouse is a critical component of the company's supply chain management, ensuring that materials are stored under optimal conditions to maintain their quality. We observed the systematic organization of inventory, the use of advanced storage systems, and the stringent protocols in place to manage the flow of materials.

2. **Production Department:** The production department was the next focus of our visit. The maintenance team explained their routine checks, preventive maintenance schedules, and the importance of timely repairs to avoid any disruptions in production.
- 7. Interaction with Employees and Management: The visit concluded with an interactive session where we had the opportunity to engage with the employees and management of Glory Pharma Chem Pvt. Ltd. The staff members shared their experiences and insights into working in the pharmaceutical industry. This interaction was highly beneficial, providing us with practical advice on career development and the skills required to succeed in this field.
